This Policy applies to the Company's activities in the United States of America only. Additionally, this Policy supersedes and completely replaces the privacy policy applicable to Tokyo Ohka Kogyo Co., Ltd.

Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is to not use our Website. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this Policy. If you are accessing or using the Website on behalf of an entity, you represent and warrant that you are authorized to agree to this Policy on behalf of such entity. References to "you" and "your" throughout this Policy means you personally, and, if you are accessing or using this Website on behalf of an entity, you and such entity on whose behalf you access the Website. This Policy applies to information we collect:

- On this Website.
- In email and other electronic messages between you and this Website.

It does not apply to information collected by:
